#### **Background**

Data used in this report are published using the super output area geography. There are currently two levels – Lower Super Output Areas (LSOAs) and Middle Super Output Areas (MSOAs).

#### **Lower Layer Super Output Areas**

Lower Layer SOAs were first built using 2001 Census data from groups of Output Areas (typically four to six) and have been updated following the 2011 Census. They have an average of roughly 1,500 residents and 650 households. Measures of proximity (to give a reasonably compact shape) and social homogeneity (to encourage areas of similar social background) are also included. The specific homogeneity criteria used related to type of dwelling - e.g., detached/semi-detached etc. - and nature of tenure - e.g., owner-occupied, private rented etc.

1.09% of LSOAs were changed following the 2011 Census in order to maintain the characteristics described above. There are now 34,753 LSOAs in England and Wales.

#### **Middle Layer Super Output Areas**

As with the Lower Layer, Middle Layer SOAs are generated automatically by zone-design software using census data from groups of LSOAs. They have a minimum size of 5,000 residents and 2,000 households with an average population size of 7,500. They fit within local authority boundaries.


Following the 2011 Census 0.11% of MSOAs were changed in order to maintain minimum and average population criteria. There are now 7,201 MSOAs in England and Wales.

In Exeter there are 74 LSOAs and 15 MSOAs.

#### Weekly income

The latest small area estimates of household income were published in December 2016 and relate to the 2013/14 financial year. Average household weekly income ranges from £580 to £900 (approximately £30,243 to £46,929 per year).

#### **Indices of Deprivation**


The 2015 edition of the English Indices of Deprivation measure relative levels of deprivation in the 32,844 LSOAs in England. The indices consist of seven domains with most of the indicators used being from 2012/13. The overall Index of Multiple Deprivation is produced by combining the seven domains using various weightings:


- Income Deprivation (22.5%)
- Employment Deprivation (22.5%)
- Education, Skills and Training Deprivation (13.5%)
- Health Deprivation and Disability (13.5%)
- Crime (9.3%)
- Barriers to Housing and Services (9.3%)
- Living Environment Deprivation (9.3%)


Each LSOA is given a score for each of the domains which is then converted into a rank. A rank of one indicates the most deprived area, a rank of 32,844 indicates the least deprived. The following tables show the most deprived LSOAs in Exeter in the various domains.

# **Unemployment**


The number of people claiming Job Seeker's Allowance or Universal Credit and are required to seek work and be available for work is the headline indicator of the number of people claiming benefits principally for the reason of being unemployed.

In Exeter there were 935 people unemployed and claiming benefits in January 2017. This equates to 1.1% of the working age population. The corresponding figure for Devon is 1%, and the UK is 1.9%.
